### **SEARCH FOR SPIDERS ON FATHER'S DAY**

Celebrate Father's Day with another 'daddy.'

Spend time with dad, daddy long-legs and other arachnids while hiking the 1.2-mile Quarry Trail, **Sunday, June 15** at **11 a.m.**, at Deep Lock Quarry Metro Park, 5779 Riverview Rd., Peninsula.

Naturalist Nicki Schneider will look for eight-legged creatures around the trail and under rocks and logs. "Visitors will learn about the importance of spiders and the many ways they're beneficial," Schneider said. Participants should expect moderate terrain.

The program coincides with the Spider Exhibit, which features photography and arachnid artwork from different artists, on display through October 31 at the Nature Realm Visitors Center, 1828 Smith Rd., Akron. The hours are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday, and noon to 5 p.m. Sunday.
