## Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What does STOMP stand for?

A: Summit Tour of Metro Parks

Q: What happens if it rains?

A: STOMP is held rain or shine, and there are no refunds.

Q: I registered early, but now I can't participate. Will I still get my free T-shirt?

A: Yes. While there are no refunds, you can pick up your T-shirt at F.A. Seiberling Nature Realm, 1828 Smith Rd., Akron, after September 3.

Q: Why do you charge a convenience fee for online registration?

A: The \$3 per-person fee is collected by Active.com. You can avoid the fee if you register by mail.

Q: Do I have to wear a helmet?

A: Yes. All participants are required to wear helmets.

Q: If my child rides on the back of my bike, do I have to pay for him/her?

A: No, but Citizens for Metro Parks will gladly accept a donation.

Q: If my child rides on the back of my bike, does he/she still receive snacks and lunch?

A: Yes.

Q: Can I buy a T-shirt on the day of the event?

A: Yes. A limited number of T-shirts will be sold at Howe Meadow for \$10 on a first-come, first-served basis.

Q: Can I bring my dog?

A: Yes, but dogs must ride with their owners. Therefore, big dogs would not be appropriate for safety reasons. Also, dogs are not permitted in the lunch/festival area at Howe Meadow. If you bring your dog, it must be kept on a leash at all times, and you are responsible for cleaning up after your pet.
