FREE LAKE SWIMMING AT MUNROE FALLS, SILVER CREEK

Enjoy free lake swimming at two popular Metro Parks during Summer Celebration, **Saturday, June 14** from **10 a.m. to 8 p.m.** Locations include Munroe Falls Metro Park, 521 S. River Rd. in Munroe Falls, and Silver Creek Metro Park, 5000 Hametown Rd. in Norton.

Except for Summer Celebration, an admission fee or season pass is required to enter Munroe Falls Metro Park during swim season, which is May 24 through August 24. At Silver Creek, only the beach area requires a daily fee or season pass.

Daily admission is \$4 for adults and teens, \$3 for ages 2 to 12. Children under two are admitted free.

Season passes may be purchased online at www.summitmetroparks.org until July 15, and at either park throughout the 2008 season. Passes for Summit County residents are \$30 for adults and teens, \$15 for ages 2 to 12 and seniors 65 and older. The out-of-county rate is \$35 for adults and teens, \$20 for ages 2 to 12 and seniors.
