SWIM SEASON BEGINS MAY 24

Lake swimming begins **Saturday, May 24** at Munroe Falls Metro Park, 521, S. River Rd., Munroe Falls, and Silver Creek Metro Park, 5000 Hametown Rd., Norton. Both swimming areas will be open daily, **10 a.m. to 8 p.m., through August 24.**

Daily admission at each location is \$4 for adults and teens, \$3 for ages 2 to 12. Kids under 2 are always admitted free.

Season passes may be purchased online at www.summitmetroparks.org. The cost for Summit County residents is \$25 for adults and teens, \$10 for ages 2 to 12 and seniors 65 and older. The out-of-county rate is \$30 for adults and teens, \$15 for ages 2 to 12 and seniors. After May 24, the rates increase by \$5.

During swim season, an admission fee or season pass is required to enter Munroe Falls Metro Park. At Silver Creek, only the beach area requires a daily fee or season pass.
