**TAKE TIME TO REMOVE TRASH FROM TOWPATH**

Volunteers are needed to help remove trash from the Ohio & Erie Canal Towpath Trail, starting at the Clinton Trailhead, 2749 North St., Clinton, **Saturday, June 7** from **9 a.m. to noon**. Registration is required.

Laura Franchetti, volunteer coordinator, explained there is a variety of junk just off the trail, located in a flood zone near the Stark County line, including cans, bottles and old clothing, toys and tires.

“This is a messy task, and we need all the help we can get,” she said.

Volunteers should be prepared for working in potentially muddy conditions. All participants under 18 must have a student waiver completed by a parent or guardian prior to participating.
