## East Room at Goodyear Metro Park

Address: Charles Goodyear Memorial Lodge, 2077 Newton Street, Akron, OH 44305

Capacity is 150. If dance **area** is requested, capacity is 100. East Room is centrally heated & air conditioned and is universally accessible. Private coat closet and unisex restroom (not universally accessible) located in the room. Restrooms and drinking fountain, located in the lobby, are universally accessible. The parking lot and walkway are lighted. Parking may be limited. *See the Agreement Form and Guidelines sheet for details.* 

**Kitchen**: (1) large refrigerator (no freezer), (1) household size microwave, (1) 100-cup-coffee urn (filters not required), food preparation counters, 4 electrical outlets for small cooking appliances, a sink (hot and cold water), (1) large beverage cooler (not freezer) chest, 3 trash containers, 2 recycle containers, a sponge mop, broom, and dustpan. **We do not provide serving utensils, dish soap, dishtowels, or dishrags.** 

**Main room**: Size: 50' x 50' with (19) 8' x 2'  $\frac{1}{2}$ ' rectangular tables that seat 8 each, 150 chairs, (2) 8' x 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ ' rectangular serving tables, 16 electrical outlets, ceiling fans, 23 windows that can be opened, and a smooth floor. If needed, an 80" flat screen monitor, the HDMI connection and cord are *available upon request*. Media equipment is **not** provided. A podium with microphone and cordless microphone are also *available upon request*.

**Outside:** There is a 35-acre field. Kitchen delivery entrance pathway is provided for drop off items only (located on Newton St, east of the building). Also provided are 2 benches and 4 standard charcoal only grills (off of kitchen, charcoal not provided).

## **Directions:**

Take I-76 east and exit at Gilchrist Road. Turn west (left) and go one block to State Route 91 (Canton Road). Go north (right) on Canton Road approximately ½ mile (second light) to Newton Street. Turn west (left) on Newton Street and go approximately ½ mile to the park entrance on the right.
