

Pioneer Shelter at Goodyear Heights Metro Park

Address: 550 Frazier Ave, Akron, OH 44305

Capacity is 80. There are 10 picnic tables (none are universally accessible), 3 standard charcoal only grills (charcoal not provided), 2 electrical outlets, and a large open field. *The fireplace at the shelter is not a working fireplace. Hiking trails and fishing are nearby. The shelter is approximately 1/8 of a mile from the parking lot and is universally accessible. The restrooms are approximately 300 feet from the shelter and are universally accessible. There are lights at the shelter and in the parking lot. Parking may be limited. See *the Permit Information and Guidelines sheet for details*. Pets are not permitted in the buildings, or beach, shelter, picnic, and play areas of the park.

Directions:

Coming from the north: take I-77 South, then take I-76 East and exit at Gilchrist Road. Turn left and go to State Route 91 (Canton Road), the first light. Turn right onto Canton Road and go approximately 1/2 mile to Newton Street, the second light. Turn left onto Newton Street and go 3/4 of a mile to Frazier Avenue. Turn right onto Frazier Avenue. The road will dead-end into the Pioneer parking lot.

Coming from the south: take I-77 North, then take I-76 East and exit at Gilchrist Road. Turn left and go to State Route 91 (Canton Road), the first light. Turn right onto Canton Road and go approximately 1/2 mile to Newton Street, the second light. Turn left onto Newton Street and go 3/4 of a mile to Frazier Avenue. Turn right onto Frazier Avenue. The road will dead-end into the Pioneer parking lot.
